







Tisinh rethelife cycle begins with the Lying of frog eggs, often in or near water bodies. The eggs are enclosed in a jelly-like substance for protection.

Times to ansitional stage within the tadpole phase. Tadpoles develop their hind legs, allowing them to swim and maneuver more effectively.






4. Tadpole with Bury Hi. I and Front

In this stage, tadpoles grow their front legs in addition to their hind legs. They start to resemble the adult frog more closely.






5. Tadp le wi 1. > Si ort Tail:

Tapole turther transform by absoring their long tail. which shortens significantly. Their gills begin to recede, and they start to develop lungs.






6.Adult 1 (3 Sage:



The Amazing Life Cycle of a Frog
